

JurAlst — Confidentiality Agreement

1. Confidential Information

Confidential Information includes all non-public business, legal, technical, strategic or operational information disclosed in connection with JurAlst services.

2. Confidentiality Obligations

Recipients agree to protect Confidential Information using reasonable technical and organizational safeguards and not to disclose it without authorization.

3. Legal and Professional Secrecy

Users must not upload information protected by attorney-client privilege, professional secrecy or statutory confidentiality obligations unless explicitly permitted under a separate agreement.

4. Exceptions

Confidentiality obligations do not apply to information already public, independently developed or lawfully obtained from third parties.

5. Return and Deletion

Upon request or termination of the relationship, Confidential Information shall be deleted or returned unless retention is required by law.

6. Governing Law

This agreement is governed by Swiss law, with jurisdiction in Zurich, Switzerland.
